History

The Kain Memorial was made possible by the collaborative efforts of York County Students Against Drunk Driving who designed the memorial and the surrounding garden originally dedicated on May 8th, 1987.



“Dedicated in memory of the innocent victims of alcohol related (crashes) in York County since 1980” is inscribed on the plaque on top of the pylon.

The Memorial is re-dedicated every few years and new names continue to be added in spite of well published awareness efforts to educate drivers of the tragic consequence which can result from driving under the influence. The most recent rededication occurred May 18, 2019
