# **JUVENILE COURT**

## **Delinquency**

Juvenile delinquency actions will be heard at times individually scheduled before Judges Adams and Flannelly. Review hearings will be heard at 1:30 p.m. on Fridays before hearing officers. Detention hearings will be heard at 1:00 p.m. on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays before hearing officers. Misdemeanor adjudications will be heard at 1:30 p.m. on Thursdays before hearing officers. Petitions to certify cases for transfer to the adult criminal division will be handled at times individually scheduled before Judges Adams and Flannelly.

## **Dependency**

Juvenile dependency actions will be heard at times individually scheduled before Judges Marceca Strong, Menges, Platts and Snyder. Safety plan, shelter, status and permanency review hearings will be held at 1:00 p.m. on Mondays and Thursdays before hearing officers.

## **Fee Petitions**

Petitions for payment of fees for court-appointed counsel in juvenile actions will be filed with Judge Marceca Strong January 1 through June 30, and with Judge Menges July 1 through December 31.

# **FAMILY COURT**

## **Bench Warrants**

Appearances on served bench warrants will be held on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays before all judges in the division, on rotation.

## **Custody**

Custody actions will be heard at times scheduled individually before all judges in the division, on rotation. Except as specified below, Motions Court sessions regarding custody will be held at 9:00 a.m. on Mondays before Judge Snyder, and when specially scheduled by Judge Menges. Custody modification and initial custody contempt motions will be referred to conciliation. Custody stipulations and agreements will be considered by the judge assigned to the case, or by Judge Marceca Strong for cases not already assigned to a judge.

## **Divorce**

Entry of divorce decrees, as well as review of and hearings on exceptions to masters' reports and recommendations, will be heard at times individually scheduled before Judges Menges, Platts and Snyder, on rotation. Motions Court sessions regarding divorce will be held at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesdays before Judge Menges, and when specially scheduled by Judge Snyder.

## **In Forma Pauperis (IFP) Petitions**

IFP petitions for all family court actions *excluding* juvenile dependencies will be heard at times scheduled individually by Judge Platts. IFP petitions related to juvenile dependency actions will be handled by the Judge assigned to the juvenile dependency case.

## **Paternity**

Paternity actions will be handled at times individually scheduled by Judge Flannelly.

## Protection from Abuse (PFA)

All petitions under the Protection from Abuse Act shall be presented through the [PFA Office](#). Hearings will be held at 1:00 p.m. on Mondays (Tuesdays in the event of a Monday holiday) and Thursdays before all judges in the division, on rotation. *Ex parte* hearings for temporary PFA orders will be heard Monday through Friday at 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. before all judges in the division, on rotation. Motions for return of weapons, modification of existing orders, and cost contempt allegations will be heard at 1:30 p.m. on Mondays and Thursdays before all judges in the division, on rotation.

## Support

Support actions will be heard Thursday mornings before Judges Flannelly, Menges and Snyder. Except as specified below, Motions Court sessions regarding support will be held at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesdays before Judge Menges, and when specially scheduled by Judge Snyder. Requests for specially scheduled *de novo* hearings for complex support actions shall be presented to the [AOYCC](#) for individual assignment and scheduling. Support contempt actions will be heard at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesdays before Judges Flannelly and Platts, on rotation, and when specially scheduled before Judge Marceca Strong.
