

# Official Notice of Election for Military and Overseas Voters

## County of York

2020 Special Election – January 14, 2020

This is an official notice of a special election to be conducted on January 14, 2020 in York County for the purpose of filling the vacancy for Senator in the General Assembly – 48<sup>th</sup> District. You may register to vote and request an official absentee ballot by using the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA), available at [www.votespa.com](http://www.votespa.com) or [www.fvap.gov](http://www.fvap.gov). You may apply for an absentee ballot by submitting your FPCA by fax to (717) 771-4387, or by email to [swkohlbuss@yorkcountypa.gov](mailto:swkohlbuss@yorkcountypa.gov).

You may request an absentee ballot from this office at any time prior to the special election. However, if time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot, you are also entitled to vote using the Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot (FWAB). Military electors may also use the FWAB to register to vote and vote simultaneously.

To vote, refer to page 3 of the FWAB.

To vote for state offices, write the names of candidates in the Addendum section of the FWAB. Under the **Office/Ballot Initiative** heading, enter the office the candidate is running for. Under the **Candidate Name, Party Affiliation or Initiative Vote** heading, list the name of the candidate you wish to vote for.
