SUBJECT: Government Performance and Results Act (GPRA) Requirements

Effective: Immediately

Based on GPRA Compliance Reports from WITS, it appears that GPRA tools are not being completed as outlined in an e-mail YADAC sent to all providers on December 13, 2019.

This memo serves as restatement that YADAC shall utilize State Opioid Response (SOR) funds for all SCA opiate use disorder individuals effective January 1, 2020. To ensure that appropriate use of SOR funds occurs, YADAC must ensure that those funds are linked with corresponding GPRA tools in WITS.

ALL SOR FUNDED OUD INDIVIDUALS must have GPRA tools completed in WITS at intake (baseline), 6-month post intake, and discharge. Failure to comply with the above requirements could lead to forfeiture of funds for services rendered.

FOR YADAC CONTRACTED INPATIENT LEVELS OF CARE:

YADAC updated the Request for Authorization (RFA) to include the date the intake GPRA was completed and the facility and person who completed it. If we receive an incomplete RFA, our staff will reach out to obtain the information prior to authorization being released. Funding will not be released until we obtain confirmation that the GPRA was complete. It is imperative that the inpatient provider communicates to the next level of care source to indicate that the intake GPRA was completed and must be consented and shared with the next provider. This will be important when determining the date the 6 month follow-up GPRA is due.

FOR YADAC CONTRACTED OUTPATIENT PROVIDERS:

If the SCA OUD individual starts treatment at an outpatient level of care, then the intake GPRA must be completed by your staff. If an individual comes to you from an inpatient level of care, it is imperative that you ensure an intake GPRA was completed and shared with you so that you know when the 6month follow-up GPRA is due. If the referring agency did not do the GPRA as they should have, then your staff will need to do this and notify me to follow-up with the referring agency.
