York County Clerk of Courts – 2018 Activities/Accomplishments

In 2018 the Clerk of Courts filed 7,672 criminal cases down from 8,279 in 2017. Juvenile delinquency filings were also down in 2018 at 1,410 cases vs. 1,526 in 2017. Overall the Clerk's office processed a total of 14,530 cases in all case categories – Administrative, Criminal, Miscellaneous, Juvenile Delinquency, Juvenile Dependency, Juvenile Miscellaneous and Summary Appeals – down by a total of 5.9%.

In 2018 the Clerk's office staff recorded 305,831 docket entries, excluding e-filed automated entries. The Clerk of Courts staffed 35,449 court events involving 13,777 defendants/primary participants regarding 17,279 cases in 2018. The Clerk's office prepared 553 State Correctional Institution commitments in 2018 up from 545 in 2017. Additionally 157 Superior Court Appeals were processed in 2018 down from 197 in 2017 and 1,352 cases were expunged in 2018 vs. 1,478 in 2017. Real time imaging or the electronic capture of filings totaled 244,707 consisting of 1,087,567 pages scanned in 2018. Over 18 million pages of court documents are available to the courts, authorized agencies and law offices. E-filing totaled 3,547 filings in 2018.

In 2018 the Costs and Fines Unit collected a total of \$11,734,831.10 – up by \$292,762.84 from 2017.
