York County Clerk of Courts – 2015 Activities/Accomplishments

In 2015 the Clerk of Courts filed 8,483 criminal cases up from 8,254 in 2014. Juvenile delinquency filings were up by 47.88% in 2015 at 1,467 cases vs. 992 in 2014. Overall the Clerk's office processed a total of 15,567 cases in all case categories – Administrative, Criminal, Miscellaneous, Juvenile Delinquency, Juvenile Dependency, Juvenile Miscellaneous and Summary Appeals – up by a total of 8.32%.

In 2015 the Clerk's office recorded 311,905 docket entries up from 305,660 docket entries in 2014. The Clerk of Courts staffed 17,520 court events involving 13,955 defendants/primary participants regarding 35,256 cases in 2015. The Clerk's office prepared 449 State Correctional Institution commitments in 2015 down from 562 in 2014. Additionally 146 Superior Court Appeals were processed down from 246 in 2014 and 1,745 cases were expunged in 2015 vs. 1,524 in 2014. Real time imaging or the electronic capture of filings totaled 252,491 or 1,372,261 pages scanned (or e-filed) in 2015 down from the 1,409,350 in 2014 for a total of 14.4 million pages of court documents instantly available via the Internet to the courts, authorized agencies and law offices.

In 2015 the Costs and Fines Unit collected a total of \$11,822,851.10 – up by \$615,929.30 from 2014.
