PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project is a historic stone masonry arch structure rehabilitation of County Bridge 258, which carries T-955 Slate Hill Road over Yellow Breeches Creek in Fairview Township, York County. The existing historic four-span stone masonry arch structure will be rehabilitated and preserved. The alignment, clearances, and structure length will remain the same upon completion of the project. This project is currently in preliminary design.

TRAFFIC CONTROL

A detour (approximately 1 mile) will be utilized while the new bridge is being constructed. This bridge is along a school bus route.
