ORDINANCE 2014-05

**AMENDMENT TO YORK COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 11, SECTION 47 FOR THE
PURPOSE OF AMENDING ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
YORK COUNTY RAIL/TRAIL AUTHORITY**

WHEREAS, the County of York adopted Ordinance 90-3 (York County Code Chapter 11, Sections 39-47) on September 5, 1990.

WHEREAS, Section 11-47 of the York County Code sets forth the Articles of Incorporation of the York County Rail/Trail Authority; and

WHEREAS, the County of York Commissioners desire to amend the Articles of Incorporation to modify the purposes of the York County Rail/Trail Authority.

NOW THEREFORE, with the above matters incorporated by reference herein, it is **HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED**, the following Ordinance amending an existing section to the York County Code:

1. The current language of Section 11-47(c) shall be eliminated and replaced with the following:

“The purpose or purposes of such Authority are acquiring, holding, constructing, financing, improving, maintaining and operating, owning, leasing, either in the capacity of lessor or lessee, projects for transportation and for parks, including linear parks, recreation grounds and facilities in and along the former Northern Central Railway line extending from the Maryland border into York County and such other projects as the Authority may from time to time select, located in or portions of which are located in York County.”

2. The remainder of Chapter 11, Section 47 shall remain in full force and effect.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.






