ORDINANCE 2017-02

**AN AMENDMENT TO YORK COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 107 REGARDING THE
LIBRARY TAX REVENUE DISBURSEMENT**

WHEREAS, the York County Code provides for a revenue disbursement of the library tax, as set forth in Chapter 107-25 of the York County Code (adopted 2-9-2005 by Ordinance No. 2005-02);

WHEREAS, the York County Commissioners wish to amend Chapter 107-25 to remove outdated language and provide updated and accurate information with regards to the disbursement of the library tax generated and collected by the County to the York County Library System;

NOW THEREFORE, with the above matters incorporated by reference herein, it is **HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED**, the following Ordinance amending an existing section to the York County Code:

Section 1. General.

The York County Code, Chapter 107-25, shall be amended, as follows:

ARTICLE III

§ 107-25. Revenue disbursement.

Library tax revenue generated and collected by the County will be disbursed to the York County Library System on a monthly basis as follows:

- A. A remittance equal to 1/12 of the estimated dedicated library tax revenue will be made no later than the 30th of each month to the York County Library System.
- B. A final reconciliation of the library tax revenue will be prepared no later than January 31st of each year to ensure that 0.10 of a mill of all real property tax revenue remitted to the County of York during the preceding year is transferred to the library system pursuant to section 25(A) of this Chapter.

Section 2. Repealer.

This Ordinance shall supersede and repeal all ordinances, resolutions and parts thereof inconsistent or conflicting herewith.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective on April 19, 2017.

Section 4. Severability Clause.

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, section or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the York County Board of Commissioners that this


Ordinance would have been adopted and would be enforceable had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.


