I. Purpose:

To establish policy that defines ancillary services for Pregnant Women, Women with Dependent Children, and Women Attempting to Regain Custody of Children.

II. Policy:

York/Adams Drug and Alcohol Commission (YADAC) requires that providers who treat Pregnant Women, Women with Dependent Children, and Women Attempting to Regain Custody of Children, treat the family as a unit when appropriate and shall also provide, or arrange (at a minimum) for the provision of the following services:

1. Primary medical care of women, including a referral for prenatal care and child care while the women are receiving treatment services:
