There is careful consideration put into each match to ensure a perfect fit!</p> <p><b>Family Group Decision Making (FGDM)</b> 717-771-9347</p> <p>Family Group Decision Making is a practice that gives authority to and empowers families by allowing them to draw on family experiences, knowledge and resources to create and implement plans that provide for the safety, permanency and well-being of their family.
