ORDINANCE 2009-03

**AMENDMENT TO YORK COUNTY CODE SECTION 112-7(a) TO INCREASE
UNIFORM PARCEL IDENTIFIER FEE**

WHEREAS, the County of York adopted a Uniform Parcel Identifier Ordinance in 1999 (Ordinance 1999-03, York County Code Sections 112-1 et. seq.);

WHEREAS, the fee stated in Section 112-7(a) is Two Dollars (\$2.00) per uniform parcel identifier per instrument;

WHEREAS, said fee has not been increased since 1999 and, as a result, is significantly lower than neighboring and similarly sized counties;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires to raise the fee to Ten Dollars (\$10.00).


NOW, THEREFORE, the York County Board of Commissioners hereby enacts as follows:

Chapter 112, Section 112-7(a) shall be amended to change the fee of Two Dollars (\$2.00) per uniform parcel identifier per instrument to Ten Dollars (\$10.00).

Effective date of amendment shall be January 1, 2010.


