ORDINANCE 2010-08

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES OF ELECTED YORK
COUNTY OFFICIALS FOR 2012 AND FUTURE YEARS**

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Board of Commissioners of the County of York, Pennsylvania the following Ordinance:

1. Ordinance 2001-06 fixing the salaries of elected officials is repealed effective December 31, 2013. Ordinance 2001-06 is amended as set forth in Section 3 below.

2. Beginning January 1, 2012, the annual base salaries of elected officials are as follows:

President Commissioner	\$85,390.19
Commissioners (2)	\$82,340.57
Register of Wills/Clerk of Orphans' Court	\$78,900.54
Controller	\$72,712.78
Treasurer	\$72,712.78
Clerk of Courts	\$72,712.78
Sheriff	\$72,712.78
Prothonotary	\$72,712.78
Recorder of Deeds	\$72,712.78
Coroner	\$72,712.78

3. For the calendar years of 2012 and 2013, the salaries of the President Commissioner and the two (2) other Commissioners shall remain frozen at the level set forth in Section 2 above. Beginning January 1, 2014, and each January 1 thereafter, the annual base salaries of the President Commissioner and other Commissioners shall be increased by the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for the Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Delaware, and Maryland area for the most recent 12-month period for which figures have been officially reported by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics immediately prior to the date the adjustment is due to take effect, such increase to be at least zero (0) percent and no more than three (3) percent.

4. The row officers shall continue to be paid in accordance with the formula set forth in Ordinance 2001-06, Section 2 until December 31, 2013. After January 1, 2014, the salaries for the row officers shall be calculated under Section 3 of this Ordinance.

5. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the York County Board of Commissioners that this Ordinance would have been adopted and would be enforceable had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.


