ORDINANCE 2011-05

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2006-05 REGARDING
"RETAP" PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the County of York is a local taxing authority authorized by Act 34 of 1971 to provide tax exemption for residential construction in deteriorated areas; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners for the County of York enacted Ordinance 2006-05 to encourage residential development in deteriorated areas in the City of York;


NOW, THEREFORE, the York County Board of Commissioners hereby amends Ordinance 2006-05 as follows:

Section 5(I). In the absence of a countywide reassessment, any applicant accepted into the RETAP program is not eligible to appeal the assessed value with regard to the parcel that is the subject of the RETAP application. Any appeal on the assessed value for the parcel at issue filed by the RETAP participant shall result in immediate removal from the RETAP program.

Ordinance 2006-05 shall remain in full force and effect except as amended above. Ordinance 2011-05 shall become effective immediately upon passage.




