

**COUNTY OF YORK, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA
ORDINANCE NO. 1996-01**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE YORK COUNTY CODE
BY DELETING SECTION 169-2 OF CHAPTER 169
AND RENUMBERING THE REMAINING SECTIONS IN CHAPTER 169**

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE I

Section 169-2 of Chapter 169 of the York County Code prohibiting political activities in County facilities is repealed.

ARTICLE II

Chapter 169 shall be amended to read as follows:

**ARTICLE I
Buildings**

§ 169-1. County facilities.

The York County Courthouse, York County Government Cents, York County Hospital and Home, County Departments Building, Youth Development Center, York County Prison and county offices at One West Marketway are facilities constructed and/or rented by the county for the conduct of county business and for the purposes of serving the taxpayers of York County.

**ARTICLE II
Use of County Equipment, Materials and Resources**

§ 169-2. Use of county equipment, materials and resources for personal benefit or gain prohibited.

County employees shall be prohibited from utilizing county equipment, materials or resources for personal use or gain.

§ 169-3. Use of property for unofficial business prohibited.

Furthermore, employees shall not use, make available or lend such property to other individuals for any purpose other than authorized, York County government business.

§ 169-4. Disciplinary action.

Violation of this Article shall subject employees to disciplinary action, up to and including dismissal.

§ 169-5. Violations and penalties.

Notwithstanding any other disciplinary action provided above, any person violating the provisions of this article shall, upon conviction, before a district justice having appropriate jurisdiction, be subject to a fine of \$300 or in default of the payment thereof, to 30 days confinement, together with all costs of suit.

ARTICLE III

In all other respects, Chapter 169 shall be and remain the same except as amended hereby.

ARTICLE IV

EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.


