

**COUNTY OF YORK, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA  
ORDINANCE NO. 1996-02**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 35 OF THE YORK COUNTY CODE PROVIDING FOR A CLARIFICATION OF THE TERM OF A SUBSCRIBER'S FEE DIRECTING THE COMPLETION OF A TRIENNIAL AUDIT AND ESTABLISHING THE DIRECTOR OF THE COUNTY'S 911 SYSTEM AS RESPONSIBLE FOR REGULAR REPORTS CONCERNING THE PUBLIC SAFETY EMERGENCY TELEPHONE ACT

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE I

Section 35-2 of Chapter 35 of the York County Code which provides:

**§ 35-2. Amount of fee.**

A monthly fee of one dollar and twenty-five cents (\$1.25) will be applied to each York County telephone subscriber's monthly telephone bill on a per-access-line basis. In the case of a Centrex or similar multiline telephone subscriber, except PBX subscribers with more than twenty-five (25) lines, the fee shall be adjusted as provided in Section 7 of the Public Safety Emergency Telephone Act.

is amended to read as follows:

**§ 35-2. Amount of fee.**

- A. A monthly fee of one dollar and twenty-five cents (\$1.25) will be applied to each York County telephone subscriber's monthly telephone bill on a per-access-line basis. In the case of a Centrex or similar multiline telephone subscriber, except PBX subscribers with more than twenty-five (25) lines, the fee shall be adjusted as provided in Section 7 of the Public Safety Emergency Telephone Act.
- B. The monthly fee shall continue at the fixed rate unless modified or changed in accordance with the procedures set forth in the Public Safety Emergency Telephone Act.
- C. The Director of the County's 911 system shall forthwith comply with the triennial auditing requirements of the Public Safety Emergency Telephone Act. In addition, the Director of the County's 911 system shall, no later

than January 15th of each year, present a report to the County Commissioners setting forth a statement of the non-recurring costs, maintenance and operating costs of the County's 911 emergency system. The Director shall certify awareness of and compliance with the auditing and other reporting requirements of the Public Safety Emergency Telephone Act.

- D. The County's 911 Director shall include the annual report with an analysis and recommendation concerning the need for contribution rate changes within the guidelines of the Public Safety Emergency Telephone Act.


ARTICLE II
