AMENDMENT TO THE CODE OF YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
CHAPTER 75, PARKS AND RECREATION

AN AMENDMENT TO THE CODE REVISING ANIMAL LEASH REQUIREMENTS AND
ESTABLISHING ANIMAL SANITATION REQUIREMENTS

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Board of Commissioners of York County
that Chapter 75, Parks and Recreation, be amended as follows:

§75-34 Animal Control and treatment; petting zoos and other demonstrations.

(3) Bring, drive, lead or carry any dog or other animal or pet which is unleashed, [or
upon a leash more that six (6) feet in length and under immediate control of a competent person,]
upon county property, except for animals used in waterfowl hunting or dog shows, as such may
be permitted by the Parks Board.


(4) [Suffer his] Allow his or her dog or pet to enter any public building or to be upon
any designated beach, except a trained and working leader dog, such as a "Seeing Eye" dog.


(7) Cause or allow his or her pet to relieve themselves without cleaning up afterwards in
designated areas.


