AMENDMENT TO THE CODE OF YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
CHAPTER 311, SOLICITATION IN COUNTY BUILDINGS

A REPEAL OF THE EXISTING AND ENACTING NEW CODE PROVISIONS
REGULATING SOLICITATION IN COUNTY BUILDINGS

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Board of Commissioners
of York County that the existing Chapter 311, Solicitation in
County Buildings be repealed and a new Chapter 311 be enacted, as
follows:

311-1 Definitions

A. Solicitation. Includes but is not limited to request
for donations, selling, chancing, or distribution of merchandise.

311-1. Solicitation in county buildings.

Solicitation in county buildings is prohibited, except for the
following:

A. Solicitations authorized by the County Commissioners.

B. Solicitations for charitable purposes authorized by a
Director in their Department or Agency.

311-2. Reporting illegal activities.

Any attempts of unauthorized solicitation should be reported
immediately to the County Administrator/Chief Clerk who will
notify the Sheriff's Office for immediate action.


311-3. Registration with municipalities required.

Authorized solicitation in county buildings may be subject to
municipal ordinances which require registration to solicit.
Compliance with any municipal requirements is the sole
responsibility of the soliciting organization or person. County
authorization to solicit does not imply compliance with any
applicable municipal ordinances.






