AMENDMENT TO THE CODE OF YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA  
CHAPTER 145, ASSESSMENTS

AN AMENDMENT TO THE CODE CHANGING THE FILING DATE FOR YEARLY  
ASSESSMENT APPEALS FROM SEPTEMBER 1 TO AUGUST 1.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Board of Commissioners  
of York County that Chapter 145, Assessment, be amended as  
follows:

§145-3. Appeals; exemption requests; deadlines

C. Appeals for yearly changes in assessment must be filed  
by the close of business, [September 1] August 1, to be effective  
for the following tax year. (NOTE: A person can appeal any time,  
but if it is after [September 1] August 1, the change will not  
take place for two (2) years). Example: If filed before or on  
[September 1, 1994] August 1, 1994, the appeal decision of the  
Board will take effect on January 1, 1995. If filed after  
[September 1, 1994] August 1, 1994, the decision will not take  
effect until January 1, 1996.
