

## ORDINANCE NO. 1999-02

On Motion duly made by Commissioner Christopher B. Reilly and  
seconded by Commissioner Shirley L. Glass, it is moved that:

An Ordinance continuing the participation of the County of York with other units of general local government in job training activities and complying with certain requirements of the Workforce Investment Act. The purpose of this Ordinance is to provide the employment, retention and earnings of participants and, as a result, improve the quality of the workforce, reduce welfare dependency, and enhance productivity and competitiveness of the county, workforce investment area and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, the participating units of general local government enacted legislation being Cumberland County Ordinance 83-2; Dauphin County Ordinance 2-83; Perry County Ordinance 83-06; Borough of Carlisle Ordinance 1427; and City of Harrisburg Ordinance 16-1983 to comply with the requirements of the Job Training Partnership Act; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance in compliance with the Job Training Partnership Act authorized an agreement between the units of general local government; and

WHEREAS, Section VII of the Agreement dated June 6, 1983, authorized the joinder of the County of Lebanon without further legislative action on their part; and

WHEREAS, the County of Lebanon by reason of Ordinance No. 11-1983 joined together with the other units of general local government and executed the agreement of June 6, 1983 on September 22, 1983; and

WHEREAS, the participating units of general local government enacted legislation being Cumberland County Ordinance 89-4, Dauphin County Ordinance 3-89, Perry County Ordinance 1-89, Borough of Carlisle Ordinance 1647, City of Harrisburg Ordinance 27-1989, Lebanon County Ordinance 15-1989, authorizing the participation of the County of Juniata in the Susquehanna Employment Training Corporation service delivery area; and

WHEREAS, by reason of Ordinance \_\_\_\_\_, the County of Juniata joined together with the other units general local government and executed the Agreement of June 6, 1983, on October 10, 1989; and

WHEREAS, the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 was signed into law by the President on August 7, 1998; and

WHEREAS, on April 23, 1999, pursuant to the Workforce Investment Act of 1998, Governor Thomas R. Ridge designated the counties of Adams, Cumberland, Dauphin, Juniata, Franklin, Lebanon, Perry and York as a Workforce Investment Area.

NOW, THEREFORE, be and it is hereby ordained by the Commissioners of the County of York as follows:

SECTION I

That the Chairperson of the Board of Commissioners and the Chief Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a joint agreement with similarly empowered representatives of the Counties of Cumberland, Dauphin, Juniata, Lebanon and Perry together with any other unit of general local government including but not limited to Adams, Franklin and York Counties designated as part of the Workforce Investment Area pursuant to the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 which agreement is attached hereto, made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "A".

SECTION II

That for the purposed of the Workforce Investment Act, the term "chief elected officials" means the members of the Board of Directors of the Susquehanna Employment Training Corporation, one of whom shall be a County Commissioner of York County appointed by separate resolution of the Board of Commissioners of York County. Said designated County Commissioner shall serve ex-officio and shall continue to serve so long as he or she shall hold said elected office or until such time as another County Commissioner is appointed by resolution of the Board of Commissioners.

SECTION III

In all other respects, the Ordinance hereinbefore mentioned of this unit of general local government are hereby affirmed, ratified and reordained.

SECTION IV

This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.

SECTION V

All actions authorized by this Ordinance completed prior to adoption are hereby affirmed and ratified.
