ORDINANCE 2000-04

AMENDMENT TO YORK COUNTY CODE SECTION 11-57

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 11-57 OF THE YORK COUNTY CODE TO MODIFY THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE APPOINTMENT OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE AUTHORITY AND THE INITIAL TERM OF ONE MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE AUTHORITY.

Chapter 11, Authorities, Section 11-57(e), Articles of Incorporation, is amended as follows:

The first paragraph is amended as follows, effective immediately.

Board of authority: The Board shall consist of seven (7) members. Three (3) members shall be chosen and appointed by the York County Commissioners (YCC). Two (2) members shall be recommended by the York County Industrial Development Authority (YCIDA) and appointed by the York County Commissioners in their sole discretion. Two (2) members shall be recommended by the York County Economic Development Corporation (YCEDC) and appointed by the York County Commissioners in their sole discretion. Each member shall be a citizen and resident of York County. If the recommending body fails or refuses to recommend sufficient prospective members which are satisfactory to the Board of County Commissioners, within thirty (30) days of the end of the term of the member subject to reappointment or replacement, the Board of County Commissioners shall appoint or reappoint, as applicable, the appropriate members in its sole discretion.


The term of Richard Reinhardt shall be amended from three (3) years to five (5) years.

All other provisions of Section 11-57 remain unchanged.
