ORDINANCE 2001-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE YORK COUNTY CODE, CHAPTER 11, SECTION 10,
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE YORK COUNTY HOSPITAL AUTHORITY TO
INCREASE THE AUTHORITY BOARD FROM FIVE (5) TO TWELVE (12) MEMBERS

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Board of Commissioners of the
County of York, Pennsylvania the following Ordinance amending Chapter
11, Section 10 of the York County Code as follows:

Section 11-10(e), Articles of Incorporation, is rescinded in its
entirety, and the following Section 11-10(e) is enacted:

(e) There shall be twelve (12) members
on the Board of the Authority who are
authorized to conduct all business of the
Authority. Authority members shall be
appointed by the County Commissioners of York
County, Pennsylvania and shall serve for a
five-year term. Such additional seven (7)
members to be members as appointed by the Board
of County Commissioners to the Board of the
General Authority of South Central Pennsylvania
and to take office upon approval of the
Articles of Amendment by the Secretary of the
Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and to have terms
of office similar to the terms as members of
the Board of the General Authority of South
Central Pennsylvania.

All other provisions of Section 11-10 are not affected by this change
and shall remain in full force and effect.
