ORDINANCE 2001-06

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES OF ELECTED YORK
COUNTY OFFICIALS FOR 2002 AND FUTURE YEARS

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Board of Commissioners of the County of York, Pennsylvania the following Ordinance:

- 1. The Resolution dated October 15, 1997 fixing the salaries of elected county officials for the years 2000, 2001, 2002, and 2003 is repealed effective December 31, 2001.
- 2. Beginning January 1, 2002, the annual base salaries of elected officials are as follows:

3. Beginning January 1, 2002, and each January 1 thereafter, the annual base salaries of York County elected officials in Section 2 shall be increased by the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for the Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Delaware, and Maryland area for the most recent 12-month period for which figures have been officially reported by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics immediately prior to the date the adjustment is due to take effect, such increase to be at least three (3) per cent and no more than five (5) per cent.

A. The Controller, Recorder of Deeds, Coroner, and Retirement Board Secretary shall receive the annual base salary in Section 2, plus the cost-living-adjustment in 2002, and annually thereafter.

B. In 2002 and 2003, the President Commissioner, Commissioners, Register of Wills, Treasurer, Clerk of Courts, Sheriff and Prothonotary shall continue to receive only the annual base salary in Section 2 for the years 2002 and 2003. In 2004, the annual salary to be received by these elected officials shall be the annual base salary in Section 2, plus the compounded annual cost-of-living adjustments given to elected officials in Subsection A above in 2002 and 2003, with annual cost-of-living adjustments thereafter.

4. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the York County Board of Commissioners that this Ordinance would have been adopted and would be enforceable had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.
