ORDINANCE 2001-07

AMENDMENT TO YORK COUNTY CODE AMENDING SECTION 301-11 AND ADDING A
SECTION TO CHAPTER 325

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION AMENDING SECTION 301-11 TO INCLUDE THE PLEASANT ACRES ANNEX AND OTHER BUILDINGS AS REQUIRING THE USE OF STAFF IDENTIFICATION BADGES AND ADDING A SECTION TO CHAPTER 325 TO AUTHORIZE A PENALTY FOR LATE FILING OF MONTHLY TAX COLLECTOR REPORTS.

1. Chapter 301 Security, Section 301-11 Identification badges, Subsection A, is amended to include "the Pleasant Acres Annex and other buildings as may be designated by the Board of Commissioners". The amended Subsection reads as follows, effective immediately:

All staff within the County Government Center, the County Courthouse, the Pleasant Acres Annex, and other buildings as may be designated by the Board of Commissioners, will be issued identification cards which will include photo ID, name and other relevant information as may be deemed needed for security and payroll processing under the time and attendance system.

2. Chapter 325, Collection of Taxes, is amended to include the following Section, effective immediately:

Filing of Reports.

A. Each tax collector shall on or before the tenth day of each month provide a true, verified statement, in writing on a form approved by the Department of Community and Economic Development, to the County Treasurer for all taxes collected for the County during the previous month, giving the names of taxables, the amount collected from each, along with discounts granted or penalties applied, if any, and the total amount of taxes received, discounts granted and penalties applied. The report shall be reconciled from the tax duplicates to the amount of taxes remaining to be collected.

B. If a tax collector does not provide the statement, including the reconciled reports within the prescribed period, the County shall impose a Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per day late filing fee for each day or part of a day, excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, for the first six days that a statement with reconciled reports is overdue; and Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each day or part of a day, excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, for each day after the sixth day that a statement with reconciled reports is overdue. The maximum late filing fee payable with respect to a single statement with reconciled reports shall not exceed Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00)

C. If the County determines that there is a reasonable cause for failure to timely file the statement with reconciled reports under this Section, the County may waive the late filing fees.

D. The County Treasurer shall receive an overdue statement with reconciled reports even if any late filing fee due has not been paid, but the statement with reconciled reports shall not be considered filed until all fees have been paid. No further late filing fees shall be incurred, notwithstanding the fact that the statement with reconciled reports is not considered filed.


