ORDINANCE 2003-08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE YORK COUNTY CODE,
CHAPTER 75, PARKS AND RECREATION, TO PROHIBIT
THE FEEDING OF WILD ANIMALS AND REDUCING THE
MAXIMUM INCARCERATION PENALTY TO TEN (10) DAYS

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Board of Commissioners
of the County of York, Pennsylvania the following Ordinance amending
Sections 75-34 and 75-41:

Section 75-34. Animal control and treatment. [add new Section 75
34A(8)]:

(8) to feed, except in such areas designated as a feeding area
by the Parks Director, wild animals, including but not limited to,
geese, ducks, deer, birds and squirrels in County parks and recreation
facilities.

Section 75-41. Violations and penalties.

The maximum term of imprisonment is changed to ten (10) days.
All other provisions of the Section remain unchanged.


This amendment shall take effect immediately.


All other provisions of the Chapter remained unchanged.

Ordained and enacted this 15th day of October, 2003.




