ORDINANCE 2005-01

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 2004-06, SECTION 179-82.

An Ordinance amending Section 179-82. Subsections (1) - (5) of Section 179-82 are amended to omit the phrase "and/or fidelity or surety company agent." Section 179-82 shall now read as follows:


1. The professional bondsman shall maintain a suitable place of business in a fixed location in York County, with a street address. Post office boxes are not acceptable as a business address.
2. The professional bondsman shall visibly identify the place of business as a bail bondsman's office.
3. The professional bondsman shall have a telephone, listed in his or her name under the address of the office.
4. The professional bondsman shall answer the telephone in a manner indicating that the location is a bail bondsman's office.
5. The professional bondsman shall authorize and designate a suitable individual, by specific name, at the place of business to accept service of process.

All provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
