ORDINANCE 2005-02

ADDITIONS/AMENDMENTS TO THE YORK COUNTY CODE

It is HEREBY ORDAINED and ENACTED, by the Board of Commissioners of the County of York, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, the following Ordinance adding new sections and amendments to the York County Code.


1. An addition to the Code incorporating an Agreement pursuant to the Workforce Investment Act of 1998, as attached hereto and incorporated herein.
2. An addition to the Code incorporating procedure for reopening the 2004 Budget, as attached hereto and incorporated herein.
3. An amendment to the County Code Section 451 incorporating the Designation of the York County Transportation Authority as Coordinator of Services, as attached hereto and incorporated herein.
4. An addition to the Code incorporating an enhancement to the South Central Keystone Opportunity Expansion Zone, as attached hereto and incorporated herein.
5. An amendment to the County Code Section 197 incorporating Declaration of Disaster Emergency, as attached hereto and incorporated herein.
6. An addition to the Code establishing an Administrative Policy Advisory Committee and adoption of the following Policies: Confidentiality, Donation of Sick Time, Animals Permitted in County Facilities, Right-To-Know Act, Smoke-Free Workplace, as found in the Procedures Manual on file in the Human Resource Department, where it is available for inspection.
7. An amendment to the County Code Section 11 regarding the issuance of new bonds by the York Hospital Authority; the administrative staff of the General Authority continuing to provide all necessary staff support to the Hospital Authority; and the Hospital Authority committing all of its net income to support economic development through the York County Economic Development Corporation.

8. An addition to the Code incorporating Payment Agreement to the County for residents of the York County Nursing Home, as attached hereto and incorporated herein
9. An addition to the Code incorporating the adoption of the following Policies: Leave of Absence Without Pay, Americans With Disabilities Act, Separation From Employment, as found in the Procedures Manual on file in the Human Resource Department, where it is available for inspection.
10. An addition to the Code recognizing and supporting the efforts of the Codorus Implementation Committee Charter Statement, as attached hereto and incorporated herein.
11. An addition to the Code supporting the Northwest Triangle Initiative, as attached hereto and incorporated herein.
12. An amendment to the County Code Sections 107 and 239, implementing a dedicated Library Tax, as attached hereto and incorporated herein.
13. An amendment 859 to the County Code Section 75 implementing the following policies: Sports Field, Overnight Camping and Open Space, as attached hereto and incorporated herein.


