ORDINANCE 2009-05

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FEE STRUCTURE FOR WEIGHTS AND
MEASURES DEPARTMENT OF COUNTY OF YORK**

WHEREAS, the County of York ("County") and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, by and through the Department of Agriculture ("PDA") have entered into a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") dated May of 2007; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the MOU with PDA, the County is obliged to perform inspections and tests to ascertain the accuracy of various devices used in commerce including, but not limited to, fuel pumps and scales; and

WHEREAS, the County has been performing said inspections and tests at the exclusive cost to the taxpayer and has not charged fees to the entities that own or rent the fuel pumps and scales subject to inspection and testing; and

WHEREAS, the County intends to set up a fee schedule comparable to similarly situated counties concerning inspection and testing of fuel pumps and scales.

NOW, THEREFORE, with the above-referenced matters incorporated by reference herein, **IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED**, by the Board of Commissioners of the County of York, Pennsylvania, the following Ordinance:

Section 1. Fees

A. Fuel Pumps. The County of York Weights and Measures Department shall charge an inspection fee to every owner or tenant operating a fuel pump. The inspection fee shall be Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per grade. In other words, if an inspection is performed on a single pump with three (3) separate grades, the total inspection fee for the pump will be Thirty (\$30.00) Dollars.

B. Scales. The County of York Weights and Measures Department shall charge an inspection fee of Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars per scale inspected and/or tested.

Section 2. Payment

A. The County of York Weights and Measures Department shall submit an invoice to the owner or a tenant of the entity operating a fuel pump or scale in a commercial enterprise physically located in the County of York shortly after performing the inspection and/or test.


B. The invoice shall be considered past due thirty (30) days after the date of the invoice. Past due invoices are subject to interest at the rate of 1% per month. In the event the County of York is required to retain an attorney to collect the past due invoice, cost of collections, including attorney fees, may be added to the amount of the past due invoice.

Section 3. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective as of January 1, 2010.




