

READY FOR RELEASE CHECKLIST

BEFORE LEAVING YORK COUNTY PRISON:

- 2 months before release – Arrange a home plan
- 6 weeks before release – Apply for medical assistance
- 4 weeks before release – Submit parole plan to York County Adult Probation
- 2 weeks before release – Arrange transportation home

WHEN YOU LEAVE YCP, YOU SHOULD HAVE:

- 3-day supply of your meds
- All property from your property box
- A check for any money left on your YCP account

I NEED CLOTHING

- 1 MONTH BEFORE RELEASE: If you don't have weather appropriate clothing to wear on the day of your release:
 - Contact the friend or family member who will pick you up and ask them to bring clothes for you.
 - If you do not have anyone to bring clothes, the Admissions department will supply a sweat-shirt and sweat-pant.

I NEED HEALTHCARE

APPLY FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE (MA)

6 WEEKS BEFORE RELEASE: If you are on any medications or have physical or mental health needs, submit a request slip to your counselor to apply for Medical Assistance. You'll need to supply the address where you'll be living upon release.

MEDICATIONS

DAY OF RELEASE: IF YOU WERE ON MEDS WHILE AT YCP, be sure to request a 3-day supply of your meds on the day of your release.

IMPORTANT NOTE: If you get released and you were not given your 3-day supply of meds – DO NOT LEAVE THE YCP GROUNDS – go to the front lobby entrance and ask them to page someone from PrimeCare to bring your 3-day supply of medications.

I AM A VETERAN

You may be eligible for special Veteran’s services.

When a veteran becomes involved in the York County criminal justice system, depending on the nature of the offense, he or she is given the option of participating in the York County Veterans Court.

Those who have committed certain serious crimes, like murder or sexual offenses, will not be permitted to participate.

After that, each veteran's eligibility is determined on a case-by-case basis. Screening the veterans is the probation department and the district attorney's office.

If approved, the veteran appears before Judge Craig Trebilcock. The veteran is enrolled in a treatment program to help heal the veteran's alcoholism, post traumatic stress disorder or other issue.
