Enter the City or Zip; a listing of psychologists, psychiatrists, therapists and counselors are provided.

Click “Locate a Therapist,” accept the disclaimer and click “Search United States.” Search by zip code or city and state. All members of the American Association for Marriage and Family Therapy (AAMFT) that fit the criteria will be provided.
- [www.yellowpages.com](http://www.yellowpages.com)
  - Search for “Marriage Counselor” and enter your zip code or city and state information. All counselors and therapists who specialize in marriage counseling are returned.
  - Search for “Social Worker, Counseling Services” and enter your zip code or city and state information. All social workers who provide counseling services are returned.
  - Search for “Churches – [desired denomination]” and your zip code or city and state information. All churches that fit the criteria are returned.
