## **Sex Offender Conditions**

*The conditions of supervision for sexual offenders, in addition to the general conditions of Probation and Parole, shall be as follows:*

1. Defendant shall be required to obtain a sex offender evaluation by an agency designated by the York County Adult Probation Department and follow through with all recommendations as per such evaluation including successful completion of the sex offender program. Defendant shall assume all responsibility for the costs of any required program.
2. If Defendant's offense qualifies under Megan's Law, Defendant shall be required to follow the Sexual Offender Registration procedures as currently applicable under state law.
3. If Defendant is subject to the DNA requirements (Act 14 of 1995 or Act 57 of 2002), Defendant will be required to follow through with testing procedures as arranged by the Probation/Parole Officer.
4. Defendant shall be required to obtain approval before leaving the jurisdiction of the Court and Defendant must secure travel permission before leaving the state. If directed by the Probation/Parole Officer, Defendant will keep a log of his or her activities.
5. All employment and/or volunteer work must be approved by the Probation/Parole Officer.
6. Defendant shall have no contact whatsoever with any victims in the case unless otherwise specified by a Court Order. Defendant shall be responsible for restitution for the victim's counseling if appropriate.
7. If Defendant's current offense involved a minor child, there will be no unauthorized contact with minors. Any contact with minors must be pre-approved by the Probation and Parole Department. Prohibited contact includes, but is not limited to: frequenting any area or activity which is regularly attended by minor children (e.g. schools, playgrounds, swimming areas, carnivals, arcades, religious services and events, malls, and similar facilities or events); residing with minor children; occupying or traveling in a motor vehicle with minor children; cohabiting, sharing, or visiting a residence with an individual who has minor children.

8. Defendant shall not purchase, possess, or transport any sexually explicit or pornographic material, or nude images. This includes, but is not limited to, photographs, magazines, movies, videos/DVDs, sexually explicit stories, and similar material. Defendant shall not own, possess, or view any materials identified by an evaluation or during treatment as being related to or part of his or her "offense cycle"[i.e. materials that have been a part of or led to Defendant's sexual offense].
9. If Defendant's offense involved the use of a computer or other electronic device, Defendant is prohibited from the use of the Internet.
10. Defendant shall not have any alcohol, illegal drugs, or drug paraphernalia anywhere in his or her residence, vehicle, or property. Defendant shall be responsible for the removal of any existing alcohol, illegal drugs, or drug paraphernalia from his or her residence, vehicle, and property. Defendant shall also be responsible to insure that no one in his or her household brings any alcohol, illegal drugs, or drug paraphernalia into his or her residence during his or her term of probation or parole. If found, any alcohol, illegal drugs, or drug paraphernalia will be presumed to be the Defendant's.
11. Defendant shall be required to undergo counseling (i.e.: Mental Health, Drug & Alcohol, or other designated counseling) if deemed appropriate by the Probation/Parole Officer.
12. Defendant is subject to the search of his or her person, property, and residence. All contraband found is subject to seizure, and may be used as evidence in the revocation process.
13. Defendant must agree to follow these conditions completely, and execute a copy of sex offender conditions. Any exceptions granted by the Probation/Parole Department must be in writing and any such exceptions may be revoked at any time if either the Probation/Parole Officer or treatment provider deemed it necessary.
14. Any cost associated with any of the sex offender condition requirements, including any treatment programs or counseling, shall be the responsibility of the Defendant and shall be paid as directed by the Defendant's Probation/Parole Officer.
15. If a Defendant is granted the right to appeal after the normal time for filing an appeal has expired, and if the Defendant is not incarcerated, the Defendant shall continue to be supervised by the York County Adult Probation/Parole Department and shall be subject to these conditions.
